# **AWARDS**



Udaipur Cement Works Ltd. was awarded as the national Winner in "EnerCon 2020" organized by CII-Godrej GBC, under category of "Creating Awareness On Efficiency & Energy Conservation" for "Prime Generation of Green Energy" in which energy efficient technologies, maintenance & operational best practices, end uses, design & operational systems, policy etc. has been highlighted by 237 entries organizations, out of which top 5 entries were awarded as the winners.

In the poster presented, UCWL emerged out as a catalyse in the movement for energy efficiency and a promoter of energy management in the country. It was evident that the initiatives taken by UCWL aims to accelerate the adoption of energy efficiency at the operational levels and help spread more awareness across sectors.

UCWL acclaimed to use renewable energy resources to increase GREEN power contribution by more than 50%, which is so far highest in the Indian Cement sector, which was acknowledged by CII through its demonstration to generate 40% of total electrical energy consumption from WHRS while maintaining its auxiliary consumption below 4%, resulting into more than 35 units energy generation per ton of clinker production.

# **CSR ACTIVITIES**













## **INAUGURATION OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTER**

Inauguration of 02 Skill Development Center (SDC) established at Mines & Plant Colony by Udaipur Cement Works Limited respectively was held with an objective to empower women coming from the underprivileged sections living in and around mines & plant area, through developing their skills so that they can earn a sustainable livelihood for their families. Initially, 2 courses of 03 months viz. Stitching course and computer course with a total of 86 (42 Mines & 44 Plant) beneficiaries are started. Mines SDC was inaugurated by Principal of Government School Namri and Ghanoli whereas Plant SDC was inaugurated by Sub Divisional Officer; Mavli in presence of other dignitaries, senior officials and ladies club members. The model and curriculum for training have been developed in line with industry requirements. On successful completion, all participants would get a certificate.

### **EYE CHECK- UP CAMP**

Free eye check-up camps in association with Unnati Sansthan was conducted by Udaipur Cement Works Limited primarily for the truck drivers, helpers & cleaners at factory and mines office premises with an objective to provide effective eye care solutions by diagnosing people's visual defects and then quickly providing them with required remedial measures like spectacles. This one-day camp ensuring all COVID- 19 precautionary measures, comprised comprehensive eye check-up including right from the patient's registrations, proper check- up and consultancy on vision related issues of around 155 patients, around 55 patients who were identified to have refractive errors, were offered with spectacles. This program ensures benefit to the bottom-of-the pyramid in our product value chain primarily truck drivers, helpers & cleaners.

## **HEALTH CAMPS**

We recognize the challenges of the underprivileged from rural areas to access healthcare especially during challenging time of COVID- 19. Thus, as a socially responsible corporate, conducting health check- up camps for the underprivileged around mines periphery has been one of the activities which are done on regular basis by Udaipur Cement Works Limited under CSR. During the camps attendees are also provided free medicine according to their health issues. These free medical camps are conducted by internal medical team across various locations around on the Thursday of every week, strictly ensuring COVID- 19 precautionary measures i.e. spraying of disinfects at camp venue, compulsory wearing of mask by all attendees, washing of hands with sanitizer, thermal scanning and maintaining social distancing. These camps are being conducted specifically for the people who are neither able to afford medical treatment nor having any basis knowledge regarding health and by hence in fact, this program have been a great benefit for such people especially during COVID- 19 pandemic. Till December' 20 total 197 patients visited consisting 73 women, 81 men and 43 children. This program has helped in identifying the major health problems amongst the people, especially women. Along with the treatment facilities, the beneficiaries were provided with awareness sessions on COVID- 19.

# **VETERINARY CAMP**

Livestock are an important source of livelihood for the rural population and a vital resource for agricultural development. Thus, Udaipur Cement Works Limited (UCWL) organized a free veterinary camp in collaboration with Animal Husbandry Department; Government of Rajasthan at Banjara Kheda in Dhunimata Gram Panchayat to help local villagers. Around operational area of UCWL where there are many cows, buffaloes, goats and other forms of livestock, veterinary services are not able to have sufficient reach. With this camp we tried to help the people who are unable to bring their animals to a veterinarian or hospital. The livestock farmers were informed beforehand about the camp. The camp consisted of treatment of animals suffering from any disease, vaccination, deworming, pregnancy diagnosis and general health checkup of the animals. Attendants were provided deworming medicine, lever tonic, antibiotics and mineral mixtures as per requirement of the animals. Further, tagging for Pashu Aadhaar was also done which contains a unique number. The unique ID numbers will be fed to a government platform where all the information regarding the animal will be available like name of the species, its productivity, lineage, health condition, symptoms in case of diseases etc. this will make tracing of animal easy. It was also ensured that the farmers were made aware of the diseases that may happen during this season. Since such camp is significant for the targeted group, the villagers were happy with the initiative taken by UCWL.

# SELF HELP GROUP FORMATION (SHGS), CAPACITY BUILDING & BANK LINKAGE

02 SHGs comprising of 24 women beneficiaries were formed under "Swavalamban" initiative of Udaipur Cement Works Limited (UCWL) initiated for women empowerment. Application forms attached with identity proof of all members were collected. This record will be an inherent part of the project. Further one day capacity building on "SHG Management" was also conducted to understand various key issues about SHG. This workshop witnessed informative films, insightful discussion and energizers among trainer & beneficiaries. These SHGs has started emphasizing on "Panchsutra" i.e. regular monthly meeting, saving, inter- loaning, timely- repayment and up-to-date records. It's also worth mentioning that for bank linkage of SHGs service area bank has been approached along with all requisite documents required. Both the SHGs have been successfully linked with bank.

## **COVID INITIATIVES**

Around 2293 masks (02 ply) were produced and more than 1925 masks were distributed were distributed during the period. These masks are made by our previously trained women beneficiaries of stitching trade under CSR for distribution to all internal- external stakeholders. This endeavor helped to safeguard against COVID-19 and have been instrumental in ensuring livelihood to the women too during this pandemic.

# **ONGOING CEMENT MILL-3 PROJECT**

Appointment of 15 DSO (Department Safety Officer) after providing them competency training by GM Safety Shri Sujeet Kumar Singh on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2020. Now, all DSO are performing & take care of safety related activities across the plant area.





Nav-Chetana Quality Circle has conducted 3 meetings in last quarter (Oct-Dec-2020) where efficiency of crusher was our epicenter. With the help of brain storming, why-why analysis and root cause analysis our team found that the shortage of material feeding at crusher hopper due to uncertain delays during transportation of material by dumpers on the 5 Kilometer long haul road was our main problem. So we deployed Pay-Loader to reduce the unplanned hopper empty time. Consequently, in the same available time, crusher has been run extra 40 Minutes per day. Our team is continuously working to improve the operational efficiency with the help of QC tools and techniques.

On 16<sup>th</sup> October 2020 at Mavli Gate, renovated truck parking area was inaugurated by our Senior Vice President (Comml. & HR). On this occasion tree plantation was also done. Newly renovated, this truck parking is having all basic amenities including Rest Shelter, Wash-room etc.
