Community Wellness

Goals

- To reduce preventable deaths and disease of children below 6 years with focus on infants.
- ✓ To reduce preventable deaths of pregnant women.



- ✓ To reduce death among poor, needy and vulnerable MDR-TB patients by providing them nutritional support.
- ✓ To reduce out of pocket expenditure of the community on treatment by providing low cost, rational, doorstep treatment.
- To educate, and facilitate adoption of good practices by the community such as:
 - Early registration of pregnancy preferably in first trimester for comprehensive antenatal care.
 - Institutional delivery.
 - Adoption of a suitable family planning method by the couple.

Naya Savera

Saving Lives

A flagship program in Pindwara Block, Sirohi District, Rajasthan.

Goal

To improve survival and wellbeing of mother and children under 5 years of age.



Naya Savera has created a community protection mechanism through education, doorstep surveillance, and partnership with the government that promotes health and prevents mishaps among mothers and children. Its focus is on people from the scheduled tribe in the area. The project influences key processes that affect survival, such as comprehensive antenatal care, institutional delivery, child immunisation, adoption of methods of family planning, and access to quality medical services.

It has facilitated:

- More than 7000 full ANC.
- Over 1400 institutional deliveries.
- More than 20,000 household visits.
- Over 100 awareness sessions and video shows.
- Nutritional food kits, iron tablets, health tonics, and drumstick plants distributed to pregnant women.
- Trainings for community level health workers.
- Mass vaccination camps.

Outreach Medical Camps

Primary Care

Goal

To detect health problems early, and provide rational treatment.



They are held across all plant locations.

Irrational, expensive, often delayed treatment affects the poor and marginalised communities disproportionately, leading to disease, death, and disability. Out-of-pocket medical expenses lead to economic impoverishment and poverty.

The old, infirm, and women often do not seek care and suffer instead. The Company holds routine general health clinics in the community where a doctor or nurse is available for early detection and prompt treatment of problems.

Medicines are provided at little or no cost to the patients. Additionally, women's health clinics, eye checkups, dental checkups, and other checkups are organised. On average, more than 25,000 people seek care at these clinics annually across all cement plants.

Nutritional Support

Reducing Hunger

Goal

To improve survival in poor, vulnerable patients with Multi-Drug Resistant TB (MDR-TB).



The project provides WHO-recommended staple food kits that are distributed to patients diagnosed with MDR-TB.

Poor nutritional status of people with TB, who are economically vulnerable and often poor, hampers their recovery, leading to non-recovery and even death. The patients become an economic burden for their families. In response to this highly vulnerable situation, the Company provides WHO-recommended staple food kits for a number of Multi-Drug Resistant Tuberculosis (MDR-TB) patients around our plants in Gujarat.

JKLC is one of the select Corporates nominated to Gujarat State TB Forum.

Other Health Interventions



Education for Young People

We conduct regular health camps and awareness programs for young people on personal hygiene, adolescent reproductive and sexual health, haemoglobin assessment, eye checkup, dental checkup, and treatment of reproductive tract infections, among others. We also provide affordable and high-quality sanitary napkins to adolescent girls.



Camps for Truck Drivers, Masons & Contractors

We organise medical camps and awareness sessions on HIV/AIDS and RTI/STI for truck drivers, masons, contractors, and other workers at plant locations. Additionally, we conduct awareness sessions on Silicosis in the community. We also arrange health check-up camps, eye check-up camps, dental check-up camps, and other specialised camps.



Care for Pregnant Women

Nutritional support to pregnant women & referral of pregnant women with severe anemia for treatment.



Voluntary Blood Donations

We organise blood donation camps in partnership with hospitals to save lives.

Project Swajal & Swacchta

Goal

To improve water and sanitation access for underserved communities while promoting responsible water use and reducing environmental impact.



- ✓ We continue to work to improve the water table, quality of water and access to safe drinking water to communities surrounding our plants.
- ✓ Most importantly, majority of these activities reduce drudgery of women involved in collection of water in water lean months.
- Water is not only inaccessible but very expensive in lean months, our interventions reduce out of pocket expenditure in collection of water during summers.
- ✓ We promote construction and use of toilets in house and schools.

WATER & SANITATION

Water Conservation & Management

Goal

To ensure availability of potable water, and its management.



Water Conservation

We make every effort to conserve every drop of rain in and around our plant areas. To do this, we harvest rainwater through the construction of Mini Percolation Tanks (MPTs), dig and desilt ponds, and construct check dams. We also promote water conservation activities such as farm bunding, borewell recharge, and soak pits for the benefit of the community.

In addition to this, we conduct desilting of ponds and Mini Percolation Tanks. In some plant areas, we have connected water from mining pits to village ponds to provide water for fishing and irrigation purposes.



We provide drinking water to several villages in our communities that face acute water scarcity during the summer months. Additionally, we set up 'Piyau' at various locations during the summers for the public.

In the villages, we have installed several hand pumps and continue to maintain them. Moreover, we have installed facilities for potable water for students in several government schools.



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Swacchta

We facilitate daily door-to-door garbage management in several villages in our communities. This is part of our initiative to keep villages clean. We actively encourage households to adopt individual toilets, supporting their construction in a few cases.

Project Vidya

- To ensure quality education to each and every child in communities we work with.
- ✓ To work with parents to ensure a supporting environment for children.





- To support students with remedial classes & multiple class appropriate coaching programs.
- ✓ To provide career counselling & guidance.
- ✓ To work with schools to improve their infrastructure and processes.

We all know that education is at the core of human development and empowerment. It brings transformative changes in lives of everyone in the society. There is no reason that anyone should be deprived of its benefits even if their livelihoods are unrelated to education.

It is essential that children start their education journey with quality education. In our communities, we have high enrolment among 6-14 years old, but they don't attend school regularly. There is high dropout during and after primary schooling. Further, a large percentage of boys and girls in the age group of 15-16 years are out-of-school in our rural communities. Covid-19 pandemic has worsened this situation, with many girls dropping out of school and getting married and boys joining labour force.

We work on quality education including teacher-pupil ratio, learning attainments, infrastructure, classroom processes in primary and secondary education around our plant locations.



Children Who Need Support

This is a unique project that focuses on the identification, remedial support, and mainstreaming of out-of-school, never-been-to-school, and dropout children among tribal, scheduled caste, and low-income communities. Since its inception, this project has enrolled a significant number of children in various government schools. The dropouts are either mainstreamed with schools or linked to NIOS for passing the secondary level.



We work with children from Scheduled Tribes, adolescent girls, and largely 1st generation learners.

Multiple Dimensions of Education

From Skills to Success

Goal

To support holistic education and development for individuals and communities, through initiatives that address multiple dimensions of education.



Infrastructure Enhancement in Government Schools

We improve the infrastructure of government schools to provide a better learning environment for children and teachers.

We have equipped schools with toilets, renovated their buildings, constructed boundary walls, classrooms, mid-day meal grain stores, toilets, handwash stations, drinking water systems, and water harvesting systems across plant locations.

Improved Classroom Teaching Processes

To improve classroom teaching processes and the learning of children, we have provided extra teachers for subjects such as English and Maths. Additionally, we have supported the installation of software-based "E-Learning Classes" in government schools around our plant locations. We also provide learning kits to children that include all items required for their studies.

JK Lakshmi Vidya Scholarship

The scholarship is for needy and meritorious students. It has been launched on the NSDL-TISS Vidyasaarathi Portal, an online platform that connects corporates with students and helps them effectively implement an end-to-end scholarship grant program. The objective of this scholarship program is to provide financial support to needy and meritorious students so that they can complete their education with dignity. Students who are the wards of masons, petty contractors, construction labourers, small dealers, truck drivers, and helpers from Pan India, and students residing near the Company's plants and marketing zones are eligible for classes V to post-graduation.



Education of Children with Special Needs

One of our initiatives is "Savera School" for empowering children with intellectual disability. This is supported under JK Lakshmi Cement's Jhajjar CSR unit. In this school, children are provided multiple interventions to enable them attain skills to manage their daily lives. The school is being run and managed by District Child Welfare Office (DCWO), Jhajjar, Haryana.

Coaching for Navodaya School Admission & Other Competitive Examinations

Navodaya schools provide excellent education at no cost to parents. Children also receive a suitable environment for pursuing education and all-around development. In communities around our plants, we encourage students and parents to apply for admission to Navodaya Schools. We provide coaching to students in Class V to prepare them for the entrance examination for admission into Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya. We also organise special coaching for the National Means Cum-Merit Scholarship and for professional entrance examinations.



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Career Counselling & Guidance Program

The objective of this program is to make students well-informed about career choices, help them create a career plan, and develop the skills they need to succeed. The program includes structured counselling sessions for students in grades X to XII, both group and individual sessions based on preassessment and psychometric analysis, as well as English communication and personality development sessions, skill development sessions, and more.

Project Aajivika

Professional Growth

Goal

Our mission is to facilitate sustainable livelihoods to reduce poverty and inequality by generating employment opportunities for poor households and by helping highly vulnerable households move towards economic stability.





Our Objectives Include:

- ✓ To enhance livelihood related skill & provide career counselling & support for higher education.
- ✓ To promote participation of women in employment and income generation.
- ✓ To improve the soft skills of young people and women.
- ✓ To work with small & marginal farmers to improve income from farm and livestock.
- To improve practices of farming & allied livelihoods through capacity building.

In our rural communities, we have found that young women and men are motivated to improve their living conditions, but often lack the required skills. They also lack suitable support systems for income augmentation. As part of our CSR initiatives, we run several short-term vocational training programs, such as cloth stitching and tailoring, beautician courses, basic computer training, mobile repairing, embroidery making, food processing, welding, diamond polishing, electrician training, and motor mechanic courses. These programs are run in partnership with government and polytechnic institutes near our plants in Rajasthan, Gujarat, Haryana, Chhattisgarh, and Odisha.

Skill Development & Livelihood



Livestock Development

We have launched a project in collaboration with the Animal Husbandry Department to improve livestock in project locations. The project includes doorstep services of a veterinarian for prompt and rational treatment of illnesses. We also organise camps to treat infertility in cattle and hold vaccination camps for protection of livestock. We have initiated JK Lakshmi Mobile Veterinary Unit for diagnosis & treatment of cattle.

Augmenting Income from Farm Activities

Our projects train farmers throughout the adopt suitable packages of practices that improve their yields while being sustainable. We have encouraged farmers to take up vegetable cultivation and use To support this, we have provided them with high-yielding variety (HYV) seeds and trained them on vermicomposting methods. Vermicompost beds have also including visits and interactions with Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) near our plants. Additionally, we have encouraged farmers to undergo soil testing under the Government's Soil Health Card Scheme and prepare an Individual Farmer Development Plan (IFDP) for a more focused approach.




Skill Development & Livelihood

Goals

Library & Job Preparation Centre

We set up libraries and job centres with internet access, books, and online counselling & motivational services at plant locations. Students can apply for exams and jobs there.

Our centres have become a model for district administration and other development agencies.

Training in Entrepreneurship Development

We train and support young people and persons with disabilities in various fields such as tailoring, beautician services, computer operations, artificial jewellery and more to start their own businesses. We also provide financial assistance and mentoring, and have collaborated with Haryana State Rural Livelihoods Mission for income generation. With our support, many beneficiaries have started or improved their businesses, such as tea stalls, barber shops, fruit shops and others.





Employment Linked Training Programs

We provide employment linked training to young people at different plant locations and support their placement in companies.

Mason Training Programs

Our projects organise skill training programs for masons contractors, which can ultimately lead to increased

Facilitate Access to Government's Social Security Schemes

Our projects aim to facilitate access to various government anti-poverty and social security schemes for the poor and marginalised. To achieve this, we undertake awareness programs and assist in filling out application forms, submitting them to relevant government line departments and panchayat functionaries, and following up on their progress.

Development of Social Infrastructure

Our projects work with communities to improve and strengthen social infrastructure. These include developing school playgrounds, constructing all-weather bus stop shades, renovating community buildings such as Panchayat Bhawan and Rangmanch, and setting up community library buildings. As part of our community development initiatives, we also undertake electrification and renovation work at Anganwadi and Gothan sheds. Additionally, the company engages in activities for environmental conservation, such as plantation and rainwater harvesting.





Bringing a Smile to Our Elderly

To engage with older adults (above 60 years) in the community, we provide various services such as health and medical check-ups, entertainment sessions, games, meetings, and awareness sessions on health and various government schemes.

Plantation & Cultural Programs

We also support cultural programs in the communities surrounding our various plant locations. As part of our environmental conservation initiatives, we have planted numerous trees in nearby communities, schools, and other areas close to our plants.

Employee Volunteering

The Company encourages voluntary and direct involvement of its employees in community development, imparting skills to the local community. The employees regularly participate in various CSR activities, such as health camps, school enrollment drives, food kit distribution, teaching at computer training centers, and providing technical and engineering support for the construction and renovation of community buildings, including panchayat buildings, school buildings, water supply and rainwater harvesting infrastructure in the plant's neighbouring communities.

Plant-level employees also organise fire safety training at the village and school level to raise awareness about fire safety. The plant-level "Ladies Club," whose members are mostly wives of plant employees, supports various training programs such as stitching, tailoring, beautician, embroidery, and life skills building for boys and girls in the plant villages. The Ladies Club members also organise mentoring and counselling sessions for school and college-going boys and girls from nearby villages. All of these initiatives help to create a positive impact on the lives of people in the neighbouring communities and contribute towards the sustainable development of the region.
